

Volunteer requirements for Big Brothers Big Sisters' Community-Based Program

Volunteers in the Community-Based program must...

- 1. Be at least 18 years of age.
- 2. Commit to mentoring a youth for a minimum of one year.
- 3. Commit to twice a month outings for several hours each time.
- 4. Be willing and physically able to engage in activities with an **active** child (such as soccer, biking, hiking, etc.) Other activities may include building, baking, cooking, events, etc.
- 5. Have reliable transportation, license and the NC minimum state automobile insurance. We cannot access motor vehicle records for the following states: AL, AZ, DE, DC, KS, MA, MI, MT, NJ, OH, UT, VA, WV, WI and WY. If you have a license from one of these states, please obtain a NC driver's license before submitting a volunteer enrollment form.
- 6. Be willing to pick the child up at their home and drop them back off there,
- 7. Be willing to maintain contact with the Big Brothers Big Sisters Match Support Coordinator on a monthly basis.
- 8. With the goal of building Friendships with a Purpose, be willing to help your mentee build Positive Youth Development behaviors (self-confidence, assertiveness, perseverance, a positive sense of their future and opportunities) through a variety of share d activities.
