OUR OUTCOMES

The mentoring relationships made and supported by Big Brothers Big Sisters are shown to have positive, lasting impacts on the lives of the children we serve.

Research shows that the sustained presence of a caring adult in a child's life positively impacts their commitment to stay in school, avoidance of risky behaviors and self-confidence. When compared with their non-mentored peers, Littles are:

- 46% less likely to begin illegal drug use
- 52% less likely to skip school
- 33% less likely to hit someone

According to a 2009 survey of Littles alumni:

- 77% said they are doing better in school because of their Big
- 90% agreed that their Big made them feel better about themselves
- 90% said their relationship helped them make better choices throughout their childhood.

A 2017 BBBS School Survey reported:

- 93% of Littles improved in academic performance
- 87% improved in attendance
- 92% improved in problem solving








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FRIENDSHIPS WITH A PURPOSE


We select and match mentors with children facing adversity and provide ongoing activities, training and support services for both families and volunteers to build lasing friendships with a purpose.

When matched with their "Big," "Littles" gain a role model and a friend while experiencing new things through which they build higher aspirations. These relationships provide Littles with the support they need to achieve academic improvement, grow in self-confidence, develop life skills and avoid risky behaviors, while rewarding mentors with the experience of being an integral part of that young person's success.

Thousands of children in our region are facing adversity. An enduring relationship with a caring mentor has been proven to help children develop more positive visions of themselves and their futures - and to beat the odds.

THE CHILDREN WE IMPACT

Most of the children served by Big Brohters Big Sisters of WNC live in single-parent households or with grandparents.









OUR PROGRAMS

Community-Based: Volunteers ages 18 and older are matched with children from single-parent families. "Bigs" schedule activities with their "Littles" at a minimum of two times each month.

After-School: In this program, volunteers ages 16 and older offer consistency, encouragement and role-modeling for their "Little" through engaging in fun and educational activities at the child's after-school program site.

School-Based: Volunteers ages 16 and older are paired with elementary-age youth for fun and educational activities one hour each week at the child's school.
